Abstract

This workshop will assist participants with understanding the double meanings and potential innuendo connected with different English words.

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1. INTRODUCTION

I want to create a fun workshop where we can look at how to make jokes by using innuendo and word play in English. Also, there are various meanings connected to words or phrases in English. These workshops are for business English but it should also balance seriousness and fun.

However, in preparation, I realised I will be educating people on how to commit sexual harassment in English and potentially get you or me fired. Because I am brave and because we have a long existing relationship as 'teacher/student', I will do this workshop knowing that you know the intention of learning behind it.

EXAMPLE 1

The *phrasal verb* **rub out**:

- a) I made an error and rubbed it out quickly. [delete]
- b) I had some free time and rubbed one out quickly. [masturbate]

EXAMPLE 2

Prepositions **(IN - AT - ON)**:

- a) A Polish student once told me: 'Yesterday, I was in my dentist'.
- If you look at this sentence from a technical perspective, there is only one way you can be in your dentist. Or maybe a few if you really want to be technical. But you catch my drift.

EXAMPLE 3

notice the difference in these *nouns* **(happy ending)**:

- a) The fairy-tale had a happy ending.
- b) My massage had a happy ending.

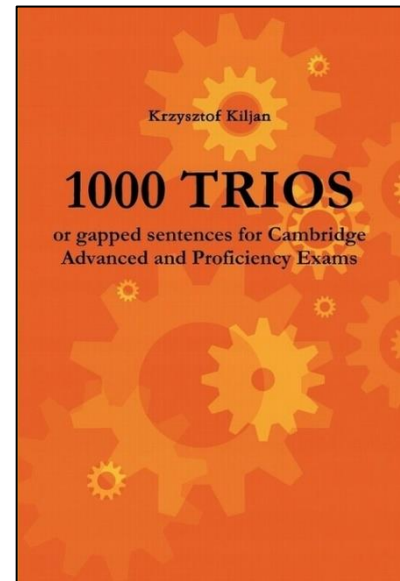
